## What is the Child Abuse Prevention Month Community Scavenger Hunt?

## How do I win?

Each time you accomplish a task, take a photo or screenshot for proof. After emailing your proof photos to PaxRiverScavHunt@us.navy.mil, including your full name, your name will be entered into a drawing. Depending on how many clues your family has accomplished, your name may go in once, twice, three or four times. During the first week of May, NAS Patuxent River Fleet and Family Support Center will draw the names of winners.
